All students in Houston ISD are tested in Kindergarten and 5th grade for G/T (universal screening). Parents are then notified of the assessment outcomes. If a child qualifies for G/T it is required to have a parent agreement of acceptance returned for the child. Parents of children in other grade levels may request that their child be assessed in the fall each school year.
